News: QCDR Status Approved Again for GIQuIC Registry

Your Input Needed for GIQuIC Survey of Non-Participants

QCDR: Qualified Clinical Data Registry for MIPS

We are pleased to announce that the GIQuIC Registry has once again been approved as a Qualified Clinical Data Registry (QCDR) for reporting to the Merit-based Incentive Payment System (MIPS) for the 2021 reporting year.

The QCDR reporting mechanism is a dynamic reporting option that allows providers to report on Quality Payment Program and QCDR measures that are meaningful to their specialty practice and foster improvement in the quality of care provided to patients.

The 2021 GIQuIC QCDR is approved to report for individual eligible providers, groups and virtual groups to the Quality, Promoting Interoperability, and Improvement Activities performance categories.

Over the last 11 years, GIQuIC has steadily grown in value as a clinical benchmarking tool for gastroenterology practices, with more than 12 million colonoscopy cases and increasing. The QCDR approval continues to facilitate the endoscopists' documentation of compliance with quality measures under Medicare.

- **IMPORTANT NOTE:** A provider or group must be registered and submitting data to the GIQuIC Registry no later than June 30, 2021 in order to be eligible to report to MIPS via the GIQuIC QCDR for the 2021 reporting year.
